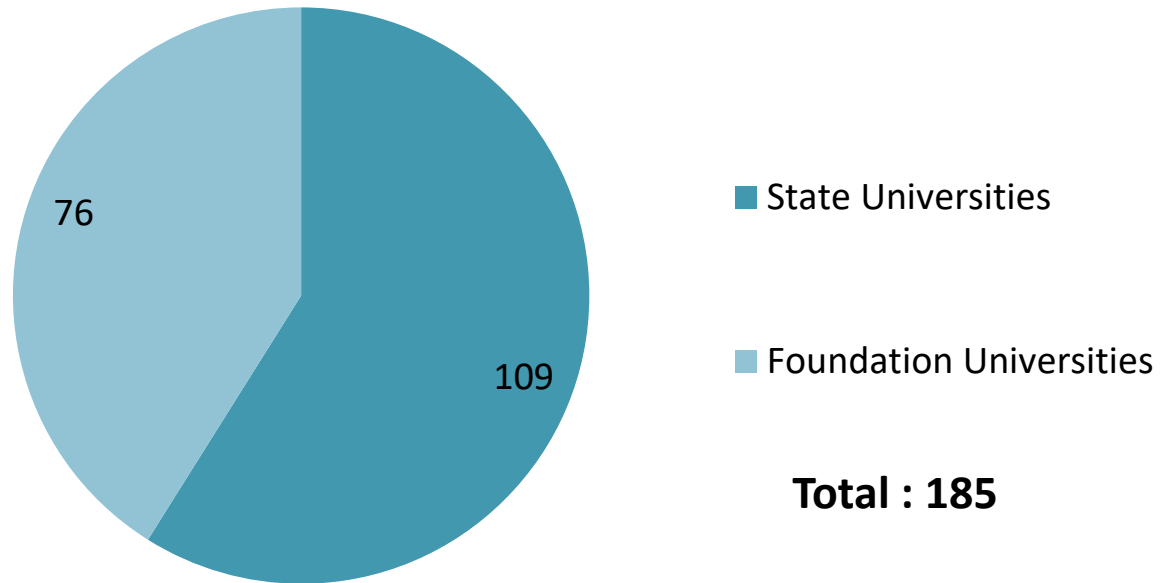

- 2) Facilitate access to information about Turkish scientific output - The interoperability of the repository with other information systems from the Turkish scientific infrastructure can also facilitate the access to information about Turkish scientific output;
- 3) Integrate Turkey in the wide range of international initiatives in this domain - NSRP allows Turkey to integrate a wide range of international initiatives in this domain and facilitates the interoperability and cooperation with research centers, funding bodies, and higher education institutions in Europe and all over the world.

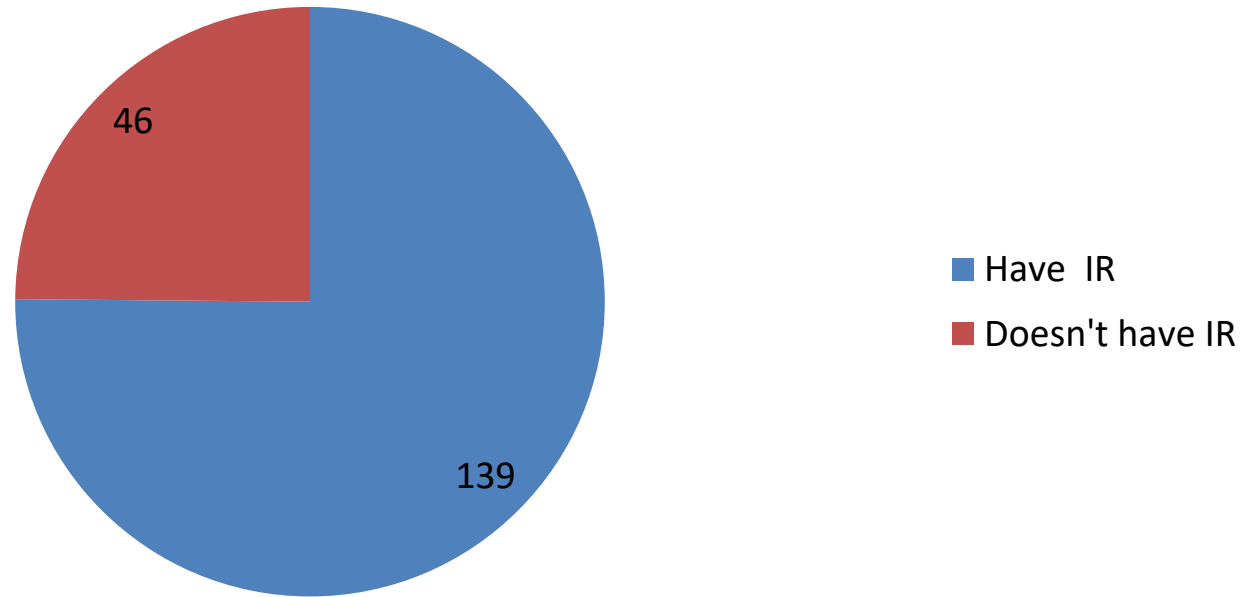

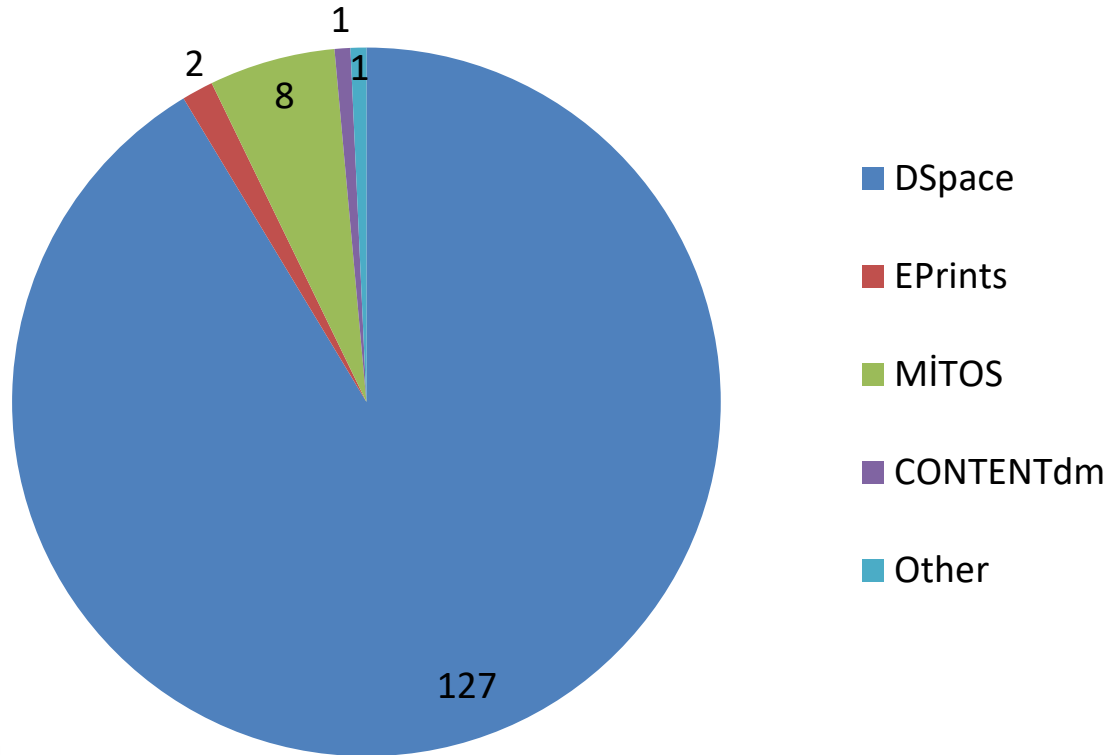

Institutional Repositories in Turkey

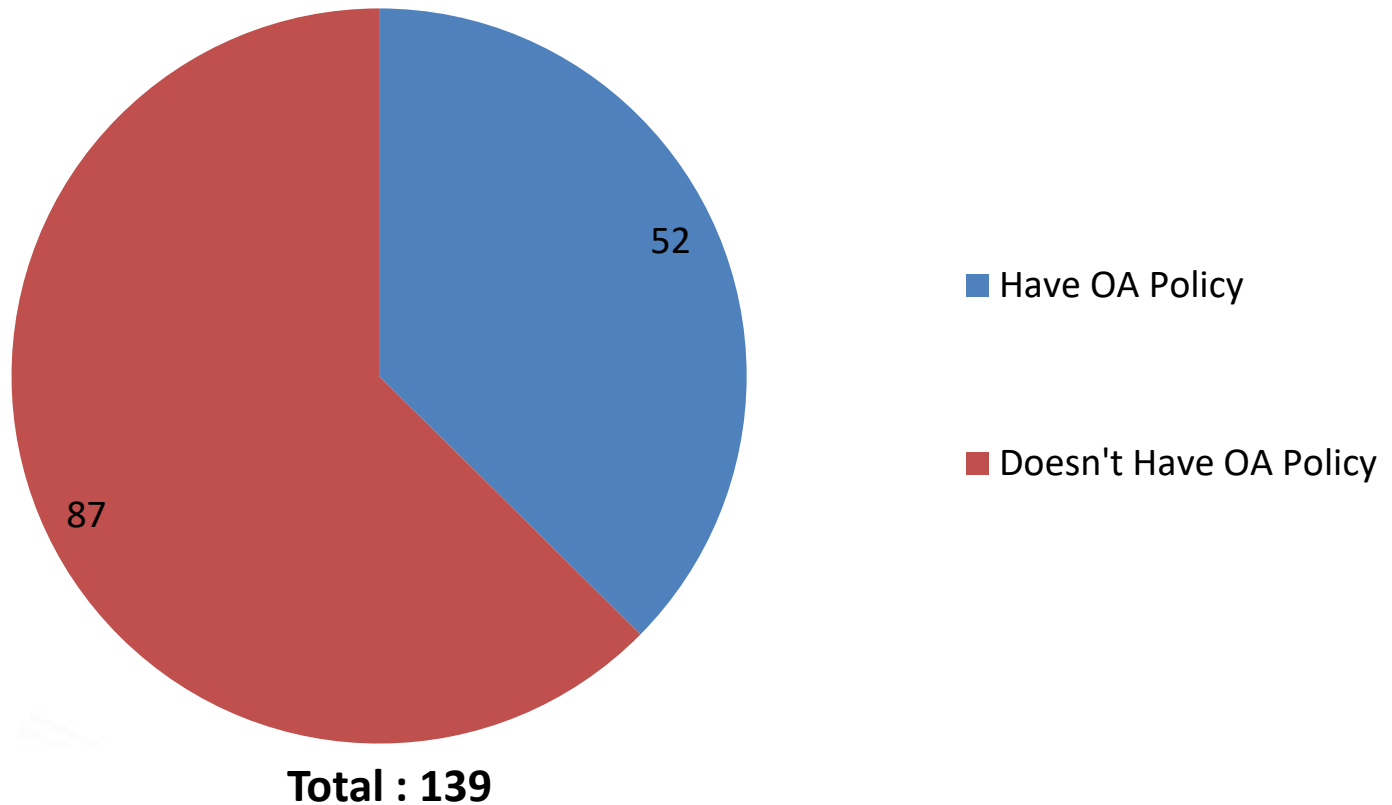


Preferred Institutional Repository Software in Turkey

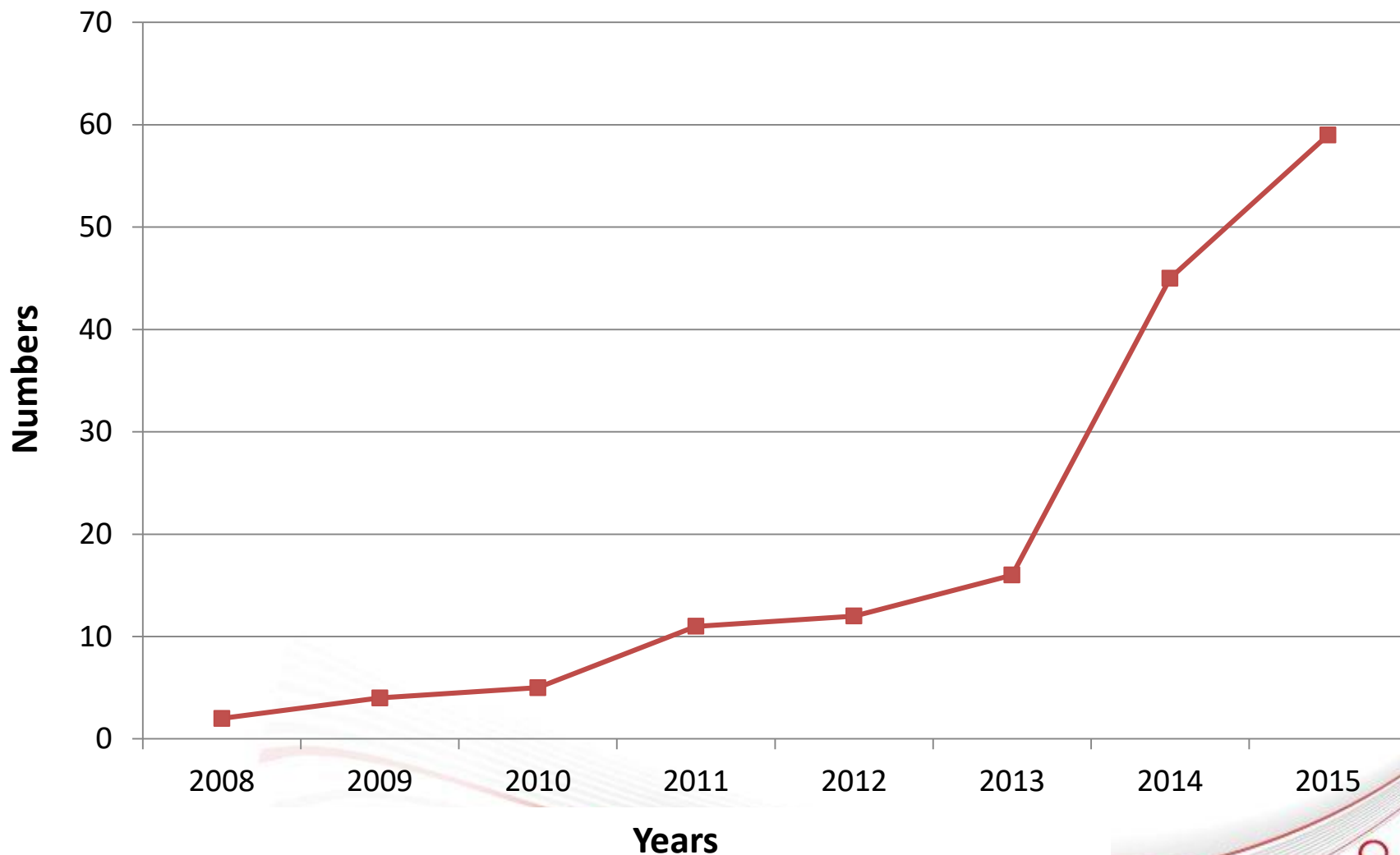

Growth of the OpenDOAR Database - Turkey



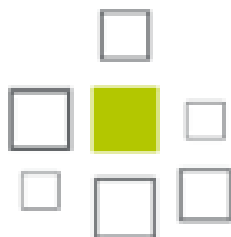
OpenDOAR Map - Turkey

Creating a Butterfly Effect to Disseminate Scholarly Information: The Turkish Experience

Removing barriers to scientific communication and the objective of creating new models of access to scientific knowledge brought research institutions, researchers and librarians together under the "open access" philosophy. All this effort, despite all the resistance from the major publishers and even sometimes the researchers themselves, took us today to the new open-access publishing models.

Since the beginning, Turkey has become one of the greatest followers of the open access initiatives both nationally and internationally.

Even though it all started with very little but great steps and there still long way to go. Over the last ten years of all this development, the lack of awareness and knowledge resulted in resistance and this prevented us to reach the desired level of success.

That's why we would like to keep "creating awareness, equipping the stakeholders with knowledge and developing ownership" are the focal points of open access initiatives in Turkey. In the light and the principles of Horizon 2020 provided by EC, many initiatives are taking in place in Europe. Turkey is also involving in number projects to strengthen and coordinate open access strategies and support institutional repository structures.

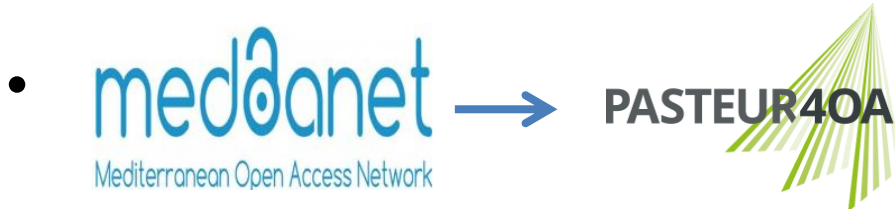

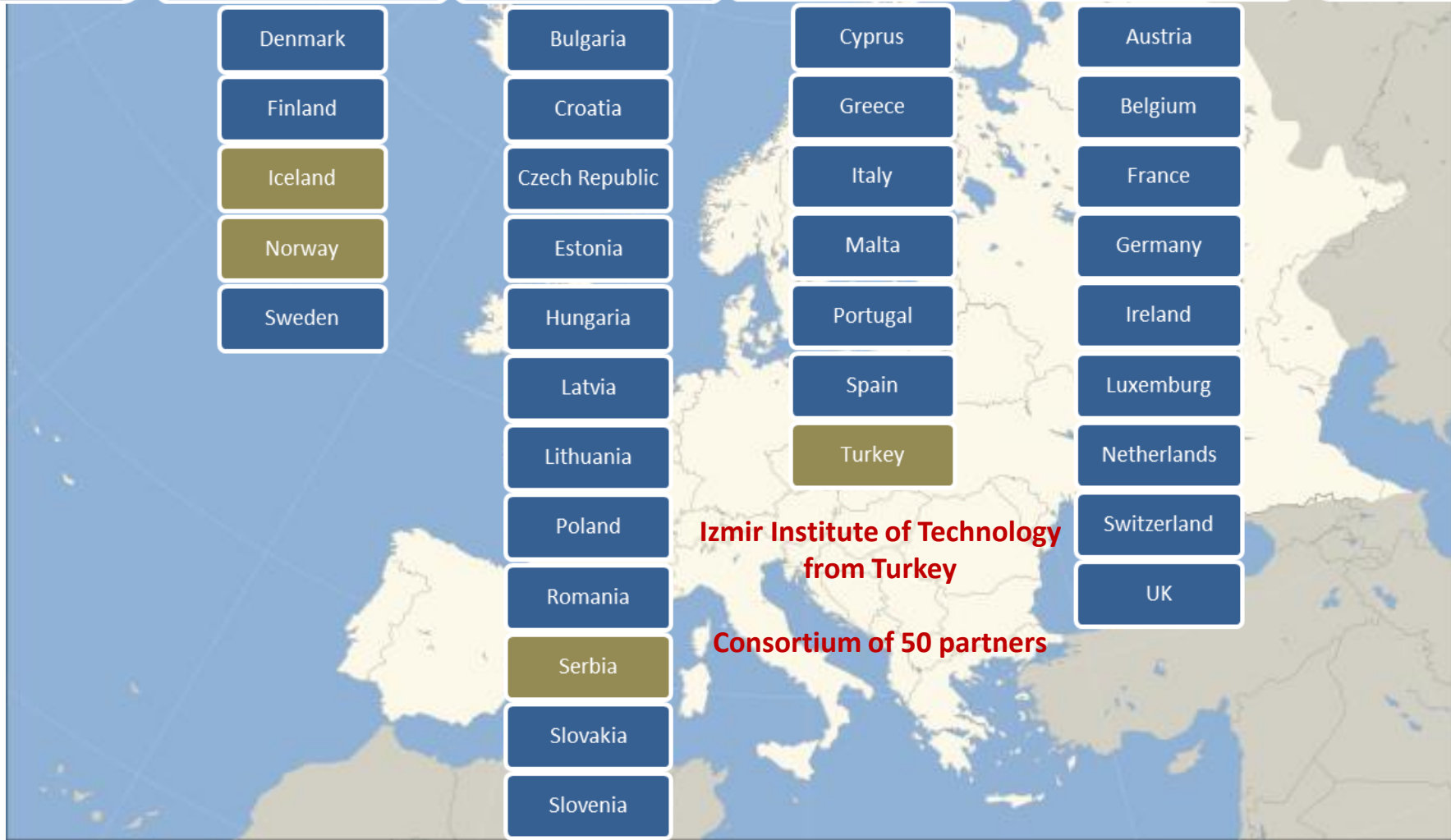

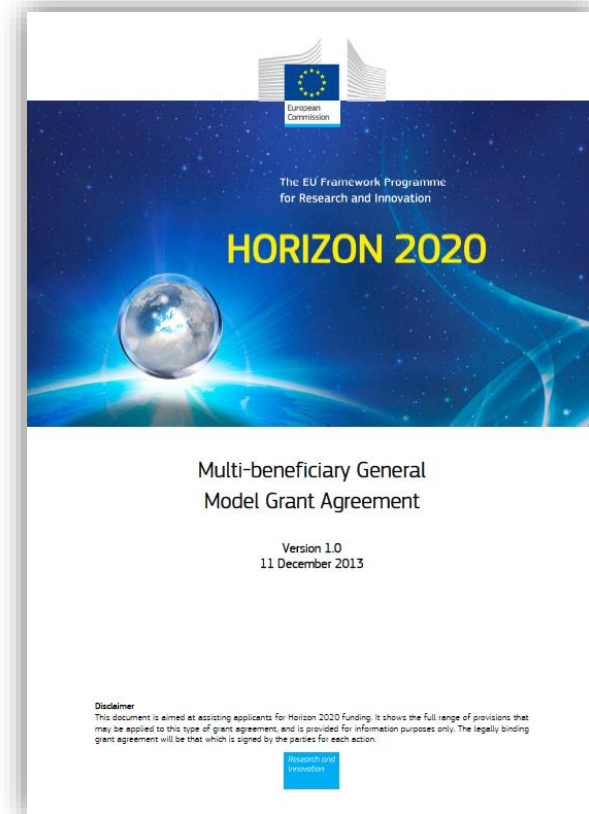

Open Access in Horizon 2020

The current OpenAIRE infrastructure and services, continued in the OpenAIRE2020 EU funded project, build on Open Access research results from a wide range of repositories and other data sources: institutional or thematic publication repositories, Open Access journals, data repositories, CRIS and aggregators.

INTEROPERABILITY IS THE KEY

Content Policy

OpenAIRE collects:

- 1) All global **Open Access research outputs**;
- 2) Relation to **funding information** if available, supporting FP7 OA pilot, **Horizon2020 OA mandate** and helping to measure research impact;
- 3) Non-open access material if related to **European Commission funding information**, or related to another OpenAIRE **affiliated funder**.
- 4) **Metadata of research datasets** from funded research projects or linked with publications in the OpenAIRE information space.

OpenAIRE will expand the current policy to other

Guidelines

OpenAIRE Guidelines provide **recommendations** to repository and other scientific information data managers about **encoding of bibliographic metadata**.

The guidelines have adopted established and existing practices for different classes of content providers:

- i) for **Literature Repositories** using Dublin Core,
- ii) for **Data Repositories** using Datacite Schema,
- iii) for **CRIS systems** based on CERIF-XML.

Specific guidelines needed to collect:

- Publication metadata;
- Funding information bodies & project grant Ids;
- Rights information and Access mode;
- Persistent identifiers for publications & datasets.

Validation & Registration

- ▶ 1. Create an account at www.openaire.eu.
- ▶ 2. Make sure your repository is registered in OpenDOAR (www.opendoar.org).
- ▶ 3. Check if your repository is compliant with the OpenAIRE Guidelines.
- ▶ 4. Run a compatibility test via the validator at <http://validator.openaire.eu>. We will guide you with any issues.
- ▶ 5. Register your repository compliant to the OpenAIRE Guidelines.

Curation & Enrichment

A rich graph of information about Open Access and funded research results is built on:

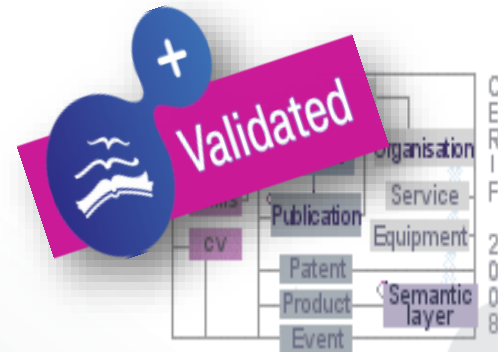
- ▶ **metadata normalization** using **controlled vocabularies**;
- ▶ **publications linked to datasets and project information**;
- ▶ **authoritative files** about projects from funder databases, **registry information** about e-journals and repositories (OpenDOAR, re3data, DOAJ);
- ▶ OpenAIRE's knowledge **extraction services** enrich metadata records with links between research outputs, citation information and similar research publications;
- ▶ **User feedback** on relationships between data and publications, manually claiming links.

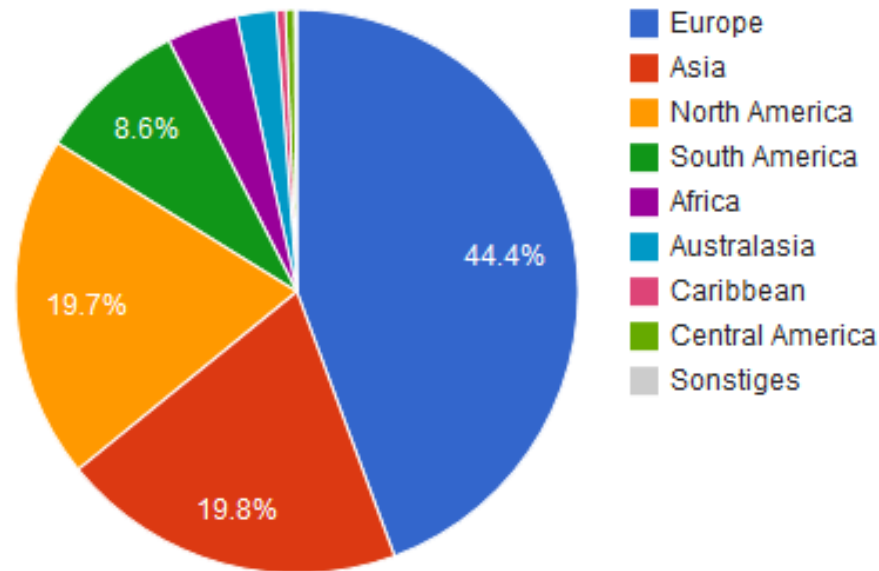

May 14, 2014: “We endorse the policies and practices that enable Open Access – immediate, barrier free access to and reuse of scholarly articles...

****Signed by numerous organizations from around the world.*

Promoting OA Clauses in your publishers licenses

e.g. “Authors from authorised institutions are permitted free of charge to promptly store their articles appearing in licensed journals generally in the form published by the publisher (e.g. PDF) in an (institutional or discipline-specific) repository of their choice and to make them available in Open Access.”

****Finland, Germany, Sweden, California, World Bank and others have already successfully negotiated these clauses into their licenses*
